Rockwood lite kits and louvers are now available in a new stock dark gray primer that will be standard upon ordering. The dark gray is a primer which will allow the product to be painted over in the field with quality adhesion.

When ordering please specify Dark Gray. We recommend using a DTM Acrylic wet paint for best results in the field.

Recommendations from the vendor:

- If the substrate contains ferrous metal and is a lighter color tinted in a white & pastel base: 2 coats of a 100% acrylic DTM
- If the substrate contains **ferrous metal** and is a **darker color made in midtone or a neutral base:** 1 coat of DTM Primer, 2 coats of 100% acrylic DTM if color
- *Due to the nature of tint bases, only the white & pastel bases are rust inhibitive. If the doors or hardware were to get scratched during transportation or installation, then flash rusting may be an issue if the scratches are not reprimed before top coating.

For optimum adhesion we recommend that the substrate is scuff sanded and free of any oil or contaminates prior to painting. Applicator should also follow any specific advice given to them by their paint supplier regarding the specific substrate being coated.
